# **ANNOUNCEMENT**

For the admission of postgraduate students in its first cycle of the Postgraduate Programme entitled "Contemporary approaches to the Performing Arts and Film (History, Theory, Identity Politics)" leading to a Master's Degree (academic year 2022-2023).

The Department of Theatre Studies of the University of Patras announces the commencement of the selection process for ten (10) postgraduate students to be enrolled in the Postgraduate Programme in the field of Theatre Studies entitled "Contemporary approaches to the Performing Arts and Film (History, Theory, Identity Politics)", as established in the Official Government Gazette, 471 / 8-2-2022 vol. B.

Candidates for the Postgraduate Progamme can be graduates from Departments of: Theatre Studies, Film Studies, Social Anthropology, Psychology, Departments of Primary Education, and from other Departments of Faculties of Philosophy and Cultural Studies. Graduates of relevant departments of the Hellenic Open University or the Greek Technological Institutions can also be admitted. The above graduates should have a degree from a Greek Higher Educational Institution or from a recognized foreign Institution of the same level.

Graduates of Greek Universities should also have knowledge of at least one foreign language (English, French, German, Italian). Knowledge of the foreign language is certified by submitting a relevant certificate of the level C1 or C2 (Advanced or Proficiency, DALF C1 or DALF C2 or Sorbonne C1 or C2, Kleines Sprach - Diplom or Mittelstufe Deutsch, Celi 4 or Celi 5 for English, French, German or Italian respectively); or, in lack of the above, a written examination is conducted to determine whether the candidate can handle the given bibliography. The examination is carried out by a committee appointed by the Assembly of the Department. International candidates

must have sufficient knowledge of Greek. Proficiency in Greek is certified by the relevant provisions as officially defined.

1. The minimum duration of studies for the award of the Postgraduate Degree is four (4) teaching semesters.

2. Written examinations are carried out during the second fortnight of September by a three-member committee appointed by the Assembly. It is preceded by the examination in the foreign language, the success of which is a precondition for the further process of the application. The exams syllabus is determined by the Assembly and is announced at least three (3) months in advance, i.e. the first ten days of June.

3. Candidates should submit to the Secretariate of the Department of Theatre Studies the following documents **no later than September 15, 2022**:

- Application form, available electronically only at: https://matrix.upatras.gr/sap/bc/webdynpro/sap/zups\_pg\_adm#

- Short CV,
- Copy of Bachelor's degree,
- Transcripts of grades,
- Foreign language titles (if any),
- Proof of research or published work (if any),
- Copy of Police ID or Passport.

Degrees from foreign universities must have the recognition of equivalence by DOATAP.

- 4. The following factors are taken into account for the selection of students:
  - (a) written examination (40%),
  - (b) oral interview (30%),
  - (c) first degree (20%),
  - (d) research or published work (10%).

Candidates who obtain a grade of at least five (5.0, on the decimal scale) in the written exams, have the right to attend an oral interview, at the end of which their final grade will be produced.
