ANNOUNCEMENT

For the admission of postgraduate students to the first cycle of the Postgraduate Programme Studies entitled "Ancient Greek Theatre and its reception", which leads to the acquisition of a Master's Degree, for the academic year 2022-2023

The Department of Theatre Studies of the University of Patras announces the commencement of the selection process of **ten** (10) postgraduate students for the Postgraduate Programme entitled "**The Ancient Greek Theatre and its reception**" in the field of Theatre Studies, which has been established by the Government Gazette 1575/8-5-2018 issue B and has been amended by the Government Gazette 1649/7-4-2022 issue B'.

Admitted to the Postgraduate Programme can be graduates with a degree of at least "Very Good" from Departments of Theatre Studies, Philology, History and Archaeology, Classics, Philosophy, Philosophy, Philosophy - Pedagogy - Psychology, History and Philosophy of Science, Primary Education, English, French, German and Italian Language & Literature as well as graduates of the Departments of the Schools of Fine Arts. Graduates of corresponding departments of the Hellenic Open University (HOU) may also be admitted. The above graduates may come from Higher Education Institutions in Greece or from recognized equivalent Institutions abroad.

Graduates of Greek Universities should also have knowledge of at least one international foreign language (English, French, German, Italian). Knowledge of the foreign language is certified by the submission of a relevant title (Proficiency, DALF or Supérieur III or Sorbonne II, Kleines Sprachdiplom or Mittelstufe Deutsch in the case of English, French, or German, respectively, etc.) or, in lack of the above, by a written language examination (translation of a foreign-language scientific text) to determine the adequate treatment of foreign bibliography. The examination will be conducted by a committee appointed by the Department's Assemply. Foreign candidates must have sufficient knowledge of Greek. Adequacy of attainment in Greek is certified as defined by the relevant provisions.

The minimum duration of studies for the award of the Diploma of Postgraduate Studies is four (4) teaching semesters.

The oral interview is conducted during the second half of September by a three-member committee appointed by the Assembly of the Department. It is preceded by the examination in the foreign language the success of which is a precondition for the further process of the application.

Candidates must apply for admission to the Secretariat of the Department of Theatre Studies no later than the **15**th **of September** 2022. The application is submitted electronically at the address:_https://matrix.upatras.gr/sap/bc/webdynpro/sap/zups_pg_adm together with the following supporting documents:

- Short curriculum vitae,
- Copy of the Bachelor degree,
- Transcript of degree records,
- Foreign language qualifications (if any),
- Proof of research or published work (if any),
- Copy of Police ID or passport.

Qualifications from foreign Higher Education Institutions must have the recognition of equivalence by DOATAP.

The following factors are considered for the selection of students,:

- (a) general degree (30%),
- (b) the average grade in undergraduate classes relevant to the scientific field of the Postgraduate Studies Programme (10%),
 - (c) the oral interview (50%),
 - (d) any research scientific, published work (10%).

Only candidates who obtain a grade of at least five (5.0, on the decimal scale) may be admitted to the Postgraduate Programme.
